LUKE 5:27-32; MARK 8:27-29; JOHN 14:15, 21, 24

*What example did Jesus give for discipleship.*

**Luke 5:27-32 NET:** <sup>5:27</sup> After this, Jesus went out and saw a tax collector named Levi sitting at the tax booth. "Follow me," he said to him. <sup>5:28</sup> And he got up and followed him, leaving everything behind. <sup>5:29</sup> Then Levi gave a great banquet in his house for Jesus, and there was a large crowd of tax collectors and others sitting at the table with them. <sup>5:30</sup> But the Pharisees and their experts in the law complained to his disciples, saying, "Why do you eat and drink with tax collectors and sinners?" <sup>5:31</sup> Jesus answered them, "Those who are well don't need a physician, but those who are sick do." <sup>5:32</sup> I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance."

#### 1. FOLLOW.

**Mark 8:27-29 NET:** <sup>8:27</sup> Then Jesus and his disciples went to the villages of Caesarea Philippi. On the way he asked his disciples, "Who do people say that I am?" <sup>8:28</sup> They said, "John the Baptist, others say Elijah, and still others, one of the prophets." <sup>8:29</sup> He asked them, "But who do you say that I am?" Peter answered him, "You are the Christ."

#### 2. BELIEVE

**JOHN 14:15, 21, 24 NET:** <sup>14:15</sup> "If you love me, you will obey my commandments." <sup>14:21</sup> The person who has my commandments and obeys them is the one who loves me. The one who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I will love him and will reveal myself to him." <sup>14:24</sup> The person who does not love me does not obey my words.
